









## SANITARY CIRCUMSTANCES OF FACE-TO-FACE LESSONS

	<p><b>Before leaving the house</b>                  If your child is showing any signs of illness, including cough, diarrhea, vomiting, loss of taste/smell or fever, make sure you take the temperature                  Above 37.8 your child must stay home.                  If any member of the household is infected with COVID you must keep your child home.                  In both cases you must inform the school.</p>		<p><b>At lunch break:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The refectory tables are cleaned and disinfected after each service. In kindergarten there will be two services</li> <li>- In areas that allow it, the students have lunch together, in groups of 6 maximum, and a distance of one meter minimum must be respected between them.</li> <li>- No food exchange must take place. Lunchtime food deliveries will no longer be possible.</li> </ul>
	<p>Upon arrival at school                  Children with a temperature above 37.8 will be sent home.                  Crowds and crossings will be limited as much as possible                  Temperature control will be carried out at the entrance.                  Accompanying persons are allowed to enter in the schools :                  - with a mask;                  - after hand disinfection.                  At the kindergarten, only one adult per child is allowed to enter. Once the child has been dropped off, the adult must leave the school.</p>		<p><b>In the playground</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Access to spaces and group games in kindergarten is authorized while respecting social distancing,</li> <li>- The provision of shared objects is possible in kindergarten</li> </ul> <p>At the elementary school, two separate breaks will be set up,                  At the secondary school, breaks will be carried out while respecting social distancing,                  Children registered in the daycare will respect the health protocol. Children are under the responsibility of a supervisor, in charge of the execution of this protocol. Parents who have the opportunity to come and pick up their children are advised to do so at the end of the classes.</p>
	<p>All day long                  Wearing mask                  Students will come with their own mask (s)                  Wearing a mask is compulsory for all students at all times, Any adult present in the establishment must also wear a mask at all times,k</p>		<p><b>What happens if a student shows symptoms?</b>                  In case of fever, or symptoms, the student will be taken to the infirmary,                  If necessary, the student is isolated wearing a mask under supervision of an adult who also wears a mask.                  You will be quickly contacted by the school who will encourage you to reach out for your doctor before any return to class.</p>
	<p><b>Hands washing</b>                  The children will wash their hands upon arrival; use of hydroalcoholic gel                  - hand washing before and after each meal                  - hand washing before and after use of toilet</p>		<p><b>After class</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cleaning of floors, of large surfaces and of most frequently touched surfaces by students and staff (tables, desks) is carried out at least once a day.</li> <li>- The premises are ventilated at least every 3 hours for 15 minutes minimum.</li> </ul> <p>This task will be performed by teachers at each recess</p>
	<p><b>.How to wash your hands properly?</b>                  Wash with soap for 30 seconds.                  Drying will be done in the open air to limit the risks,</p>		<p>These measures may be updated by the health authorities of the country depending on the circulation and the possible increase of the virus cases,                  Families will be supported according to their needs.</p>
