



Election of Parent Representatives for The School Council (Two votes per family)

Vote Directly: **Tuesday, October 26, 2021 (from 7:20 am to 4:00 pm).**
By mail until Monday, October 25, 2021 at 16:00.

Dear Sir or Madam,

You will find below the list of candidates for the School Council.

You may directly vote on **Tuesday, October 26, 2021**. The Election offices will be open from **7:20 am to 4:00 pm**.

For parents with at least one child in the elementary school, they will cast their vote for **the School Council and the School Board** in the office designated for this purpose, which is located at the elementary school entrance.

For parents whose children are in the middle school or high school, they will cast their vote **only for the School Council**, in the tent erected inside the high school close to the entrance off Churchill Road.

Identification Card is required.

The ballot must be placed in the envelope (for postal voting), or in the ballot box.

Each vote shall be personal. It is not possible to vote on behalf of his/her spouse. In accordance with the Education Code BO N°29 of July 22, 2004 and its modalities, designation to the CA of the EPLE, **voting by proxy is not allowed.**

It is possible to vote by mail. In this case, the following must be respected:

(Maximum two ballots per family to be placed in the envelope):

- The ballot provided below will be slipped into the first empty envelope (without any erasure or deletion);
- This envelope will be inserted into another envelope with the following text written on it:

- School Council Election
- Voters' Signature, the father and the mother (2 votes per family)
- Family Name (written in capital letters) and classroom of the child/ren

- This envelope will be handed over to the head master's office by the students (if you cannot come to the school) by **Monday, October 25**.

You can pick up the absentee ballot material from the head master's office starting from October 18, 2021.
